

Indoor WPC Wall Panel Maintenance Guide

Introduction:

WPC Wall Panels are known for their low maintenance requirements. To maintain their appearance and extend their lifespan, follow the care instructions outlined below.

Routine Cleaning:

1.Dusting:

• Dust the panels regularly using a soft cloth or a microfiber duster. This helps prevent dust buildup and maintains the panels' appearance.

2.Cleaning Stains:

- For cleaning stains, use a damp cloth with mild soap or detergent. Avoid using abrasive materials, as this can scratch or damage the surface of the panels.
- For stubborn stains, you may use a mild cleaning agent suitable for composite materials. Always test on an inconspicuous area first.

Preventive Care:

1. Avoid Excessive Moisture:

• WPC panels are moisture-resistant but should not be exposed to prolonged water contact or high humidity. In wet areas such as bathrooms, ensure adequate ventilation to prevent water buildup behind the panels.

2. Avoid Direct Sunlight:

• While WPC panels are UV-resistant, prolonged exposure to direct sunlight may cause fading over time. If possible, place your panels in areas with indirect light, or use curtains to protect them from excessive UV exposure.

3. Scratch Prevention:

 To prevent scratches, avoid using sharp or heavy objects against the panels. Place furniture, artwork, or decor with felt pads or soft cushioning.

Repainting or Refinishing:

• If the surface of your WPC panels starts to show wear or you wish to change their appearance, you may refinish the panels. However, avoid sanding or using harsh abrasives as it may damage the surface finish.

General Tips:

- Check the panels periodically for signs of wear and tear, especially around edges or seams.
- If any panels become loose or damaged, promptly address the issue by reapplying adhesive or replacing the damaged panel.
